

ADULT WELDING COURSE WINTER 2018

COURSE DESCRIPTION* -

This 90 hour course will include both lecture and hands-on instruction and will cover the following:

- General Shop and Welding Safety
- Blue Print Reading
- Welding Nomenclature
- Oxyacetylene Cutting
- Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW) or stick welding in flat and horizontal positions
- Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW) or MIG welding in flat, horizontal, vertical up/down and overhead
- Flux Core Arc Welding (FCAW) in flat and horizontal
- Self-paced course

Educational materials and safety equipment will be provided. Students must wear steel-toed shoes.
