Welding Program (HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

- > A 90-hour, self-paced course which includes both lecture and hands-on instruction
- > The 7-week course covers:
 - Safety (general shop and welding)
 - Blueprint reading
 - Welding nomenclature
 - Stick welding / mild steel (SMAW): flat and horizontal positions
 - MIG Welding / mild steel (GMAW): flat, horizontal, vertical up/down and overhead
 - Flux Core Arc Welding (FCAW) - flat and horizontal
 - Carbon arc gouging
 - Oxy Acetylene cutting

- > Steel-toed shoes are required

- > Educational materials and safety equipment will be provided

- > A completion certificate, recognized by area employers, will be awarded for those who successfully complete the program

SCHEDULE: Begins Tuesday, February 25, 2019

Runs every **Mon., Tues., Wed. and Thurs. from 6:00 to 9:30 p.m., February 25th through April 11th.**

COST/ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- > For high school students* the **cost is \$150.00.** The remaining portion of the course will be covered via scholarship funding.
- > Students must pass a drug test (negative results)
- > Priority will be given to seniors

* High school students must be 18 years old or enrolled in a state recognized career technical program (i.e. Tri Star Career Compact)
